We apply for grants which have helped with purchasing hanging flower baskets, new business district signage, and the “WELCOME TO YOUNGSTOWN” brochures every year which highlights each member’s business, new displays of official Village flags as well as holiday lights on Main and Lockport Streets and within Falkner Park in the heart of the Village. With projects from the grant comes improved public relations with other Niagara County communities. In 2015 the YBPA donated a commercial grade bench to the Village Community Center grounds at 240 Lockport Street in memory of the late Mayor Neil C. Riordan. In 2016 we had the signpost at Main and Lockport Streets refurbished. In June (since 2010) we provide the annual **“HERE COMES SUMMER ☺”** Street Dance on Main & Hinman Streets. This year’s dance will be June 21<sup>st</sup>, the last day of school and 1<sup>st</sup> day of summer! We also chose and then honor the **2018 “BUSINESS OF THE YEAR”**. This year’s winner is “Lakeside Quarterhorses” of Youngstown, NY. We own the domain that is kept current by the NRRCC which displays our member’s names and data. There we also host a “24/7 webcam” with views of the Niagara River flowing into Lake Ontario (beautiful sunsets free!) Working together we help make Youngstown and its environs a place you’d love to visit, start a business, and even some day call home.
